AMA FEE SCHEDULE

EFFECTIVE DATE: March 1st 2025

This Fee Schedule is for services provided under the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946

REGULAR HOURS: Monday thru Friday, 7:00am - to 3:30pm

REGULAR HOURLY RATE: Sampler, Technician, Weigher \$32.00 in quarter hour increments, minimum of 4 hours will be charged.

OVERTIME HOURLY RATE: One and one half times regular hourly rate applies to all hours outside regular hours and Saturday in addition to unit fees. Minimum of 4 hours will be charged except one hour before or continuation of regular work day.

Finance Charge: 1½% per month after 30 days of statement date.

Personnel Safety: It's the customers responsibility to make the grain, commodity, or stowage area safely accessible. Agency employees do not open or close lids on railcars or shipping containers. There must be a minimum of two people at all times on top of railcars and in the immediate vicinity at facilities where services are being performed. This can be two agency employees or one agency employee and one customer employee. This is to "render aid if needed" or to call for assistance.

Weather Policy: Agency will adhere to the following inclement weather policy: Sampling and stowage examination requests may be delayed, curtailed, or dismissed when and of the following conditions exist: High winds, rainfall, snow, ice and other conditions that are dangerous to employee and/or facility specific conditions that could put employees providing services in jeopardy. Adequate lighting must be provided when onsite services are requested after sunset.

SUNDAY AND HOLIDAY HOURLY RATE: Double regular hourly rate, minimum 4 hours, in addition to unit fees. Holidays include Presidents Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. If a holiday falls on a Saturday Kankakee Grain will observe it on the preceding Friday, holiday's that fall on a Sunday will be observed on the following Monday.



STANDBY RATES: Will be charged at applicable hourly rate for delays not caused by agency.

TRAVEL AND MILEAGE FEES: Travel time will be charged portal to portal at applicable hourly rate per employee. Mileage will be charged portal to portal per vehicle used per the IRS standard mileage rate and will be assessed per actual miles traveled. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate. (Prorated when possible)

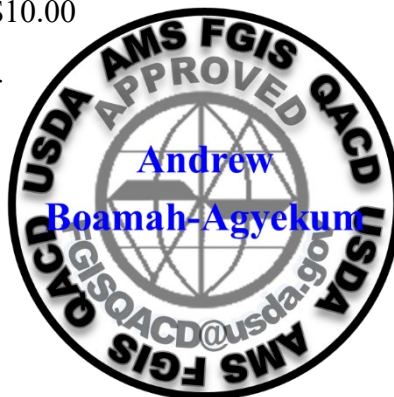

Via UPS, FED EX, etc. - in addition to carrier fees\$10.00

Commodity Cooperative Service Agreement Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, commodity cooperative service agreement fees for commodity inspection services (pulses, hops, and miscellaneous processed commodities), excluding rice, will be assessed at the current percentage rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 (Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 4.) The assessed fees must exclude travel, mailing expenses, and state and local taxes. Invoices will identify assessed commodity cooperative service agreement fees as separate line items.
